1 Name

This determination is the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Interchangeable Constituent) Determination 2024*.

2 Commencement

This determination commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Authority

This determination is made under subregulation 19AEA(1) of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Regulations 1995*.

4 Definitions

In this determination:

non-active constituent means any constituent of a registered chemical product other than an active constituent.

Note: Words and expressions used in this Determination have the same meaning as in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code* as scheduled to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* and the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Regulations 1995*.

5 Interchangeable constituent determination

The constituent of a chemical product listed in Column 1 of the Table below may be interchanged with the constituent listed in Column 2 if the requirements specified in Column 3 are met.

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Tersperse 4896	Tersperse 4894	<ul style="list-style-type: none">a) The chemical product is a registered chemical product; andb) Tersperse 4896 is a non-active constituent of the chemical product; andc) Tersperse 4896 is for use as a surfactant; andd) the registered chemical product is a suspension concentrate or flowable concentrate formulation type; ande) the concentration of Tersperse 4894 to be interchanged is the same as the concentration of Tersperse 4896 in the registered chemical product.
