The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994 (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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General information

The APVMA Gazette is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

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Agvet chemical voluntary recall: Anafol 10 mg/mL Injection

Product name: Anafol 10 mg/mL Injection

Sold by: Lyppard and Cenvet nationally between 1 April 2024 to 19 August 2024.

On 19 August 2024, Headway Investments Pty Ltd (ABN: 33 655 095 855), trading as Headway Animal Health Pty Ltd (ABN: 33 655 974 413), initiated a voluntary recall under section 106 of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code scheduled to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994 (Cth)* in relation to the chemical product described above.

Reason for voluntary recall

Small number of unexplained adverse effects pertaining to length of anaesthesia. Anafol 10 mg/mL Injection from batch number 23093K does not meet the expected safety criteria.

Hazard

Potential unexplained adverse effects pertaining to length of anaesthesia.

What to do if in possession of this chemical product

Cease use of Anafol 10 mg/mL Injection from batch 23093K immediately.

Wholesalers and end users should immediately quarantine all the stock on hand of the recalled product and contact Headway Animal Health Pty Ltd to arrange return and credit.
