The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

From February 2010, the APVMA will publish the *APVMA Gazette* in electronic format only. The *APVMA Gazette* and information about subscribing to the gazette alert service are available on the APVMA website, www.apvma.gov.au.

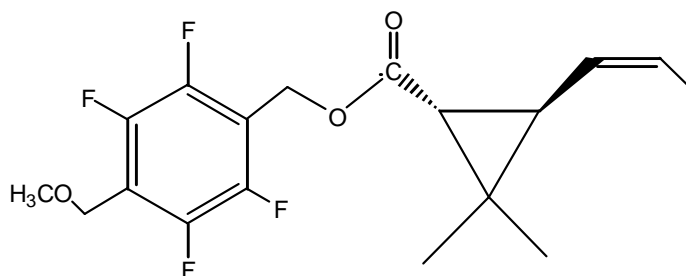

Its primary use will be in household as pest control insecticide products. It is to be used as an insect repellent and is not applied to human skin. There are no proposed agricultural uses for metofluthrin (non-food use).

SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF METOFLUTHRIN ACTIVE CONSTITUENT

The Pesticides Program of the APVMA has evaluated the chemistry aspects of metofluthrin active constituent (manufacturing process, quality control procedures, batch analysis results and analytical methods) and found them to be acceptable.

On the basis of the data provided, and the toxicological assessment, it is proposed that the following APVMA Active Constituent Standard be established for metofluthrin active constituent:

Other compounds of toxicological significance are not expected to occur in metofluthrin TGAC as a result of the raw materials and the synthetic route used.

The Office of Chemical Safety and Environmental Health has considered the toxicological aspects of metofluthrin TGAC, and advised that there are no toxicological objections to the approval of this chemical.

An Acceptable Daily Intake (ADI) and an Acute Reference Dose (ARfD) have not been set as metofluthrin is intended for non-food producing use patterns.

The National Drugs and Poisons Schedule Committee (NDPSC) may consider metofluthrin to be appropriate for inclusion in Schedule 6 of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons (SUSDP).

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisers on these criteria.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed importation and use of metofluthrin would not be an undue toxicological hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

In accordance with sections 12 of the Agvet Code, the APVMA invites any person to submit a relevant written submission as to whether the application for approval of metofluthrin should be granted. Submissions should relate only to matters that the APVMA is required by legislation to consider in deciding whether to grant the approval. These grounds include **chemistry and manufacture, and toxicity**. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Comments received outside these grounds cannot be considered by the APVMA.

Submissions must be received by the APVMA within **28 days** of the date of this notice and be directed to the contact listed below. All submissions to the APVMA will be acknowledged in writing via email or by post.
