The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*.

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## GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

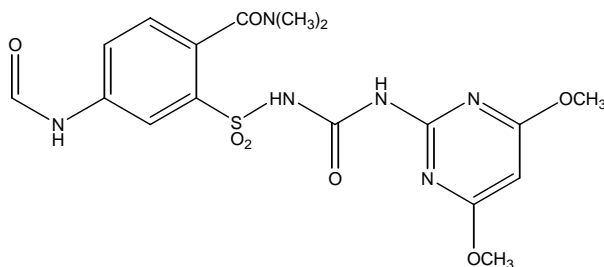
### Foramsulfuron

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has before it an application for the approval of a new active constituent, Foramsulfuron for use in the control of certain grasses in turf, including winter grass (*Poa annua*), ryegrass (*Lolium perenne*), Kikuyu (*Pennisetum clandestinum*) suppression, Paspalum suppression, and Crowsfoot grass (*Eleusine indica*).

#### SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF FORAMSULFURON ACTIVE CONSTITUENT

The Chemistry Section of the APVMA has evaluated the chemistry aspects of active constituent Foramsulfuron (manufacturing process, quality control procedures, batch analysis results and analytical methods) and found them to be acceptable. Foramsulfuron is a new active constituent and there are no compendial specifications available for Foramsulfuron.

On the basis of the data provided it is proposed that the following minimum compositional standard be established for Foramsulfuron:

Constituent	Specification	Level
Foramsulfuron	Light beige powder	Minimum 970 g/kg

Other compounds of toxicological significance are not expected to occur in Foramsulfuron as a result of the raw materials and the synthetic route used.

The Office of Chemical Safety and Environmental Health of the Department of Health and Ageing has completed a toxicological evaluation of Foramsulfuron. The report recommends that there are no objections on human health grounds to the approval of Foramsulfuron.

An Acceptable Daily Intake (ADI) and an Acute Reference Dose (ARfD) are not set based on its non-food producing use pattern. The National Drugs and Poisons Schedule Committee (NDPSC) has recommend Foramsulfuron be appropriate for inclusion in Schedule 5 of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons (SUSDP).

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisors on these criteria.

### Foramsulfuron in the product Tribute Turf Herbicide

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has before it an application from Bayer CropScience Pty Ltd, for registration of a new product containing the foramsulfuron. The product is **TRIBUTE TURF HERBICIDE**. The product is for use on control of winter grass (*Poa annua*), ryegrass (*Lolium perenne*) and crowsfoot grass (*Eleusine indica*) in common and hybrid couchgrass only (not Queensland Blue Couch).

#### SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF TRIBUTE TURF HERBICIDE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 14(3)(E) AND (F) OF THE AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY CHEMICALS CODE (THE 'AGVET CODE'), SCHEDULED TO THE *AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY CHEMICALS CODE ACT 1994*

The APVMA has evaluated the application and in its assessment in relation to human and environmental safety under section 14(3)(e) of the Agvet Code, it proposes to determine that:

- (i) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of **TRIBUTE TURF HERBICIDE** would not be an undue hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

The Office of Chemical Safety and Environmental Health (OCSEH) in the Department of Health and Ageing has conducted a risk assessment on the product and concluded that it can be used safely.

Foramsulfuron is a new herbicide to the Australian market. The product, Tribute Turf Herbicide, contains 22.5 g/L of foramsulfuron. Tribute Turf Herbicide is a new herbicidal product, which will be used for the control of various grasses in turf, including Winter grass, Ryegrass, Kikuyu suppression, Paspalum suppression and Crowsfoot grass. Foramsulfuron belongs to the chemical class of sulphydryl herbicides, which inhibit the synthesis of amino acid in plants through inhibition of acetolactate synthase (ALS). Inhibition of ALS by sulphydryl chemicals is only relevant in plants.

Following oral administration in rats, foramsulfuron was readily but poorly absorbed through the gastrointestinal tract and was rapidly excreted in the faeces and urine. The compound underwent limited metabolism with only two metabolites detected in the excreta, with the parent compound being the most prevalent recovered compound. Foramsulfuron showed no indication of being bioaccumulative. An *in vivo* dermal absorption study in male rats indicated foramsulfuron had low potential to be absorbed when applied as either an undiluted formulation concentrate or an aqueous spray dilution.

Foramsulfuron was of low acute oral, dermal and inhalational toxicity in rats. It was non-irritating to the skin, but is a slight eye irritant in rabbits. It was not a skin sensitiser in guinea pigs. The formulated product, containing 22.5 g/L of foramsulfuron was of low acute oral, dermal and inhalational toxicity in rats. It was a moderate skin irritant and a slight eye irritant in rabbits, and was not a skin sensitiser in guinea pigs. It may cause lung damage if swallowed and enters the airways.

In short-term repeat dose studies with foramsulfuron (active constituent), the toxicity effects were restricted to decreased body weight gain in female rats at very high dose levels following oral administration. No treatment-related effects were observed in similar studies in mice or dogs. There was no evidence of systemic toxicity in a repeat dose dermal study in rats with doses up to and including 1000 mg/kg bw/day. There were no treatment-related effects observed in oral subchronic and chronic studies in mice, rats and dogs.

With the exception of weak evidence of clastogenicity in a human lymphocyte chromosome aberrations test *in vitro* without metabolic activation, foramsulfuron was negative in a series of *in vitro* assays (including a further chromosome aberration assay) and in two *in vivo* tests. Furthermore, no carcinogenic potential was detected in long-term studies in both rats and mice. Foramsulfuron was neither a reproductive toxicant in rats nor a developmental toxicant in rats and rabbits.

The APVMA has considered the findings of the Office of Chemical Safety and Environmental Health and accepts these conclusions.

- (ii) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of **TRIBUTE TURF HERBICIDE** containing the active constituent foramsulfuron is not likely to be harmful to human beings if used according to the product label directions.

Workers may be exposed to the product when opening containers, mixing/loading, application and cleaning up spills and equipment. The main route of exposure to the spray will be dermal and inhalational, with potential accidental ocular exposure. Given the short term intermittent use pattern and lack of systemic toxicity in a 28-day dermal toxicity in rats (i.e. the 28 day dermal NOEL is 1000 mg/kg bw/d the highest dose tested), together with foramsulfuron's very low inherent toxicity in subchronic tests and its low volatility ( $4.2 \times 10^{-11}$  Pa (20°C)), a quantitative occupational health and safety risk assessment is not required. However, First Aid Instruction and Safety Directions and a Re-entry statement have been recommended and are shown on the product label.

The APVMA has considered the findings of the Office of Chemical Safety and Environmental Health and accepts these conclusions.

- (iii) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of **TRIBUTE TURF HERBICIDE** is not likely to have an unintended effect that is harmful to animals, plants or the environment if used according to the product label directions.

The Department of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities has assessed data in support of the proposed use and has concluded that the risks to the environment from this use are acceptable provided that amendments are made to the draft label.

Photolysis and hydrolysis are not significant degradation pathways of foramsulfuron in soil or water, except in acidic conditions. In aerobic conditions foramsulfuron degrades rapidly in soil and fairly rapidly in water/sediment systems. Foramsulfuron has high or moderate mobility in soils.

Foramsulfuron is neither acutely or chronically toxic to birds, fish or aquatic invertebrates. However, a similar formulation containing a crop safener showed higher toxicity to fish and daphnia on an acute and chronic basis. Foramsulfuron was not toxic to bees and earthworms. However, the similar formulation was harmful to the parasitic wasp and slightly harmful to the predatory mite at rates approximating the proposed Australian field rate. As expected for a herbicide terrestrial and aquatic plants were sensitive to foramsulfuron. Foramsulfuron was moderately toxic to blue-green the most sensitive algal species and the presence of the crop safener did not lessen these effects. Foramsulfuron is very highly toxic to duckweed.

In assessing the application particular attention was given to the effects of spray drift on non-target terrestrial and aquatic plants. The risk to aquatic species is acceptable with an 80 m Downwind No-Spray Zone. Similarly the risk to terrestrial plants is acceptable with a 30 m Downwind No-Spray. The risk of run-off from treated areas to aquatic species may be mitigated to an acceptable level if additions are made to the draft label to prevent run-off from treated areas. Due to its effects on beneficial insects, the use of foramsulfuron may not be compatible with Integrated Pest Management. The risk assessment determined that the chemical is unlikely to pose an environmental risk under the proposed use pattern, provided the recommended amendments are made to the draft label.

The APVMA has considered the findings of the Department of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities and accepts these conclusions.

- (iv) In relation to its assessment of efficacy under section 14(3)(f), the APVMA is satisfied that data from trials supporting the efficacy of the product adequately demonstrate that if used according to the product label directions, the product is effective for its proposed uses.
