The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.



SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF PIROCTONE OLAMINE ACTIVE CONSTITUENT

Piroctone olamine is a new active constituent and there is no compendial specification available.

The Pharmaceutical Chemistry Section of the APVMA has evaluated the chemistry and manufacturing aspects of Piroctone olamine and is satisfied that all the data requirements (including the physico-chemical properties, spectral identification, manufacturing and quality control aspects, impurity formation, active constituent specification, stability, batch analysis data, analytical methods and packaging information) necessary for the approval of this new active constituent have been met.

SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF PAW PURE ANIMAL WELLBEING – MEDIDERM GENTLE MEDICATED SHAMPOO FOR DOGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 14(3)(E) AND (F) OF THE AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY CHEMICALS CODE (THE 'AGVET CODE'), SCHEDULED TO THE AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY CHEMICALS CODE ACT 1994

The APVMA has evaluated the application and in its assessment in relation to human and environmental safety under section 14(3)(e) of the Agvet Code, it proposes to determine that:

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of PAW PURE ANIMAL WELLBEING – MEDIDERM GENTLE MEDICATED SHAMPOO FOR DOGS (MEDIDERM) would not be an undue hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

⁽Piroctone olamine has been assessed by the Therapeutics Goods Administration (TGA) and can be included in non-prescription products which are proposed for registration or listing in the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods (ARTG) without the need for further evaluation of the substance per se. Subject to the following conditions:

- Piroctone olamine is for dermal use only;
- The concentration of Piroctone Olamine is not to exceed 1.0% in wash-on/wash-off products and 0.5% in leave-on products;
- Piroctone olamine is not to be included in topical products intended for use in the eye.'

The APVMA has considered the findings and recommendations of the TGA evaluation with regards to human exposure, and accepts these findings and recommendations. The product under consideration, MEDIDERM, contains piroctone olamine at a concentration of 0.721% which, under TGA assessment for humans is:

- safe for direct human usage and therefore there is not potential human health hazards (immediate or long term) arising from proposed use of the veterinary chemical product ;
- not seen by the TGA as requiring a poison schedule classification; and
- does not require any safety directions on label.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of MEDIDERM containing the active constituent, Piroctone olamine, is not likely to be harmful to human beings if used according to the product label directions.

The APVMA has evaluated and proposes to approve the active constituent, Piroctone olamine, and finds that the chemistry and manufacturing details of the product, MEDIDERM are acceptable. The APVMA proposes to adopt similar schedule (Nil) for Piroctone olamine used in animals as that used in humans where the concentration of Piroctone Olamine does not exceed 1.0% in wash-on/wash-off products.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of MEDIDERM containing the active constituent, less than 1% Piroctone olamine is not likely to have an unintended effect that is harmful to animals, plants or the environment if used according to the product label instructions. The Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts (DEWHA) has assessed the data in support of the proposed use and has concluded that the risks to the environment from the proposed use are acceptable. The APVMA has considered the findings of DEWHA and accepts its recommendations on this criterion.

In relation to its assessment of efficacy under section 14(3)(f), the APVMA is satisfied that data from trials supporting the efficacy of the product adequately demonstrate that if used according to the product label directions, the product is effective for its proposed uses.

MAKING A SUBMISSION

In accordance with sections 12 and 13 of the Agvet Code, the APVMA invites any person to submit a relevant written submission as to whether the APVMA should grant the application for approval of active constituent Piroctone olamine and registration of the product MEDIDERM. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Such grounds should relate only to matters that the APVMA is required by legislation to take into account in deciding whether to grant the application. These grounds include occupational health and safety, chemistry and manufacture, safety and environmental fate and toxicity, and efficacy. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Comments received outside these grounds cannot be considered by the APVMA.



Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade



Pursuant to paragraph 2 of section 69C of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Act 1992*, notice is hereby given that following the fifth Conference of the Parties to the Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade, an amendment is being prepared to the export controls imposed on certain chemicals. This alteration is proposed to come into force on the day after the amendment to the Regulations is registered on the Federal Register of Legislative Instruments (FRLI).

ROTTERDAM CONVENTION ON THE PRIOR INFORMED CONSENT PROCEDURE FOR CERTAIN HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS AND PESTICIDES IN INTERNATIONAL TRADE

An amendment is being developed to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals (Administration) Regulations 1995 to prohibit any export of the chemicals specified below without written authorisation from the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry. This is proposed to take effect on the day after the amendment to the Regulations is registered on FRLI.

Under the Rotterdam Convention, export of these chemicals to countries that are Parties to the Convention for use as a pesticide may be prohibited absolutely, or only authorised if certain specified conditions given by the importing Party are met. Exporting Parties must ensure that exports do not occur when the importing country has indicated that it does not consent to imports of that chemical.

In order to meet export notification requirements under the Rotterdam Convention, chemical companies seeking to export a controlled chemical must apply to the Australian Government Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry for permission to export (contact details are at the end of this notice). Companies exporting these chemicals to countries that are Parties to the Convention must:

- i) include the Harmonised System Customs Code for the chemical (where assigned) on shipping documentation; and
- ii) ensure adequate labelling of the chemical: include information regarding risks and/or hazards to human health or the environment; comply with relevant international standards applicable to labels; and
- iii) provide to the importer (if the chemical is to be used for occupational purposes) a safety data sheet that follows an internationally recognised format, with the most up to date information available, in one of the official languages of the importing Party if practicable; and
- iv) comply with any specified conditions stipulated by the importing country and promulgated by the Secretariat to the Rotterdam Convention as advised by the authorised officer.

A person must not export an active constituent for a proposed or existing chemical product, or a chemical product, in contravention of a condition or restriction prescribed by a regulation. Penalty: 300 penalty units.

In addition to adding three new chemicals that were listed under the Rotterdam Convention at the fifth meeting of the conference of the Parties, this amendment removes mercury and methylmercury nitrite, as they are no longer listed under the Rotterdam Convention.

A person may supply or cause to be supplied active constituent manufactured prior to 9 December 2011 at wholesale and retail level, until the 9 December 2013.

After 9 December 2013 it will be an offence against the Agvet Codes to have possession or custody of the active constituent with the intention to supply, or to supply the active constituent.

USE

A person may continue to use the active constituent in accordance with the conditions of approval until 9 December 2013.

Any person who possesses, has custody of, uses, or otherwise deals with the listed active constituent in accordance with the above instructions is taken to have been issued with a permit under the Agvet Codes to so possess, have custody of, use or otherwise deal with the active constituent after the approval has been cancelled until 9 December 2013.

The supply and use of the active constituent must be in accordance with the conditions of approval, including any conditions relating to the shelf life or expiry date.

It is an offence to possess, have custody of, use, or deal with the active constituent listed in the table in a manner that contravenes the above instructions.

Amendments to the APVMA MRL Standard

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) approves maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. The MRLs approved by the APVMA are associated with a regulatory decision to register a product, grant a permit approval, or as an outcome from a review decision and are set out in the *MRL Standard* published by the APVMA. The *MRL Standard* lists MRLs of substances which may arise from the approved use of agricultural and veterinary chemical products containing those substances on commodities used for human consumption as well as livestock feeds. The *MRL Standard* also provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply. There may be situations where the residue definition for monitoring and enforcement is different to the definition used for dietary risk assessment purposes.

MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. In considering MRLs and variation to MRLs, the APVMA takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, toxicology, good agricultural practice and dietary exposure. In approving MRLs, the APVMA is satisfied, based on dietary exposure assessments and current health standards, that the limits are not harmful to public health.
