The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

The following instructions set out how a person can deal with the cancelled label approval.

SUPPLY

A person may supply or cause to be supplied products bearing a cancelled label manufactured prior to 1 February 2013 at wholesale and retail level, until 1 February 2015.

After 1 February 2015 it will be an offence against the Agvet Codes to have possession or custody of the products bearing the cancelled label with the intention to supply.

USE

A person may continue to use the product according to its cancelled label instructions until 1 February 2015.

Any person who possesses, has custody of, uses, or otherwise deals with the product bearing a cancelled label in accordance with the above instructions is taken to have been issued with a permit under the Agvet Codes to so possess, have custody of, use or otherwise deal with the product after the labels have been cancelled until 1 February 2015.

The supply and use of the product bearing a cancelled label must be in accordance with the label instructions, including any conditions relating to the shelf life or expiry date. It is an offence to possess, have custody of, use, or deal with the product listed in the table in a manner that contravenes the above instructions.

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Reconsideration of Approvals and Registrations Related to Fenamiphos

The APVMA, in accordance with Part 2, Division 4, of the Agvet Codes, intends to reconsider all approvals of the active constituent fenamiphos and registrations of all products containing fenamiphos and the approvals of all associated product labels.

In April 2003, the APVMA (formerly the NRA) initiated a reconsideration (review) of fenamiphos because of concerns relating to public health, occupational health and safety, the environment, and residues in food.

The APVMA has now extended the scope of the fenamiphos review to include reconsideration of the following fenamiphos active constituent approval (Table 1) and product registrations and associated label approvals (Table 2) that have been granted since the announcement of the fenamiphos review.

- likely to have an effect that is harmful to human beings
- likely to have an unintended effect that is harmful to animals, plants or things or to the environment.

Any person may provide relevant information to the APVMA with regard to these reconsiderations. Preliminary Review Findings Related to Approvals and Registrations of Fenamiphos

Fenamiphos is an organophosphorus insecticide and nematicide used in agriculture to control pests, particularly nematodes and sucking insects.

The APVMA, in accordance with Part 2, Division 4, of the Agvet Codes, reviewed aspects of active constituent approvals, product registrations and label approvals for fenamiphos.

In April 2003, the APVMA began a review of fenamiphos because of concerns relating to public health, occupational health and safety, the environment, and residues in food. The APVMA also considered whether product labels carry adequate instructions and warning statements. Detailed reasons for the review of fenamiphos can be found in the APVMA's Fenamiphos Review Scope document, available on the APVMA website, www.apvma.gov.au.

Following completion of the assessment of data provided for the review, the APVMA is considering the risks arising from exposure to fenamiphos and the consequences of the current findings. Assessments undertaken in the component technical reports, particularly environment and residues in food, identify a basis for which a potential risk may exist, that is an unacceptable risk to the environment, as well as an unacceptable risk to consumers.

Active constituent approvals, product registrations and label approvals affected by the review are listed in Tables 1 and 2.

PROPOSED REGULATORY ACTIONS

On the basis of the information assessed to date, the APVMA is proposing to take the following regulatory action.

The APVMA proposes to affirm all active constituent approvals listed in Table 1.

The APVMA proposes to find that it is not satisfied that the labels of the products in Table 2 contain adequate instructions in relation to the criteria set out in section 14(3)(g) of the Agvet Codes, as well as those referred to in regulations 11 and 12 of the Agvet Code Regulations.

Further, the APVMA proposes to find that it is not satisfied that the relevant particulars or conditions of label approval can be varied in such a way that the prescribed requirements for continued approval will be complied with.

Therefore, the APVMA proposes that label approvals for products listed in Table 2 be cancelled in accordance with section 40 of the Agvet Code. As a consequence of the proposed findings of the review and as prescribed in section 44(3) of the Agvet Codes, if the APVMA cancels the only approved label, or all the approved labels, for a chemical product, it may also cancel, as the case may be, the registration of the product.

As described above, the APVMA is not satisfied that label approvals can be varied in such a way that the prescribed requirements for continued approval will be complied with. The APVMA proposes that the registrations for products listed in Table 2 be cancelled under section 44 of the Agvet Codes.

The APVMA invites persons and organisations to provide submissions on this Preliminary Review Findings document directly to the APVMA. Submissions specifically addressing the areas of concern noted in the Preliminary Review Findings report must be in writing and reach the APVMA by **31 May 2013**.
