Proposed Standard for Agricultural Active Constituents—Amicarbazone and Florasulam

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has granted approvals for active constituents, amicarbazone and florasulam. Amicarbazone has been used for residual weed control in ratoon cane. Florasulam has been used for post-emergent control of broadleaf weeds in cereal crops. (For more information about these two active constituents, please refer to APVMA Gazette Notice of 5 December 2006 and of 1 August 2006, respectively).

The APVMA is proposing to set the following active constituent standards for amicarbazone and florasulam under s. 42 (3) (e) of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Medicines Chemicals Code Regulations 1995*.

THE APVMA'S PROPOSED STANDARD FOR ACTIVE CONSTITUENTS AMICARBAZONE AND FLORASULAM

Constituent	Level
Amicarbazone	Not less than 940 g/kg
Florasulam	Not less than 970 g/kg
