The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

12 months after the date listed in Column E of Table 1, it will be an offence against the Agvet Codes to have possession or custody of the product(s) bearing the cancelled label with the intention to supply, or to supply the product.

USE

A person may continue to use the product(s) bearing the cancelled label according to its label instructions until 12 months after the date listed in Column E of Table 1.

Any person who possesses, has custody of, uses, or otherwise deals with the listed product bearing the cancelled label in accordance with the above instructions is taken to have been issued with a permit under the Agvet Codes to so possess, have custody of, use or otherwise deal with the product(s) bearing the cancelled label until 12 months after the date listed in Column E of Table 1.

The supply and use of the product(s) bearing the cancelled label must be in accordance with the conditions of registration or approval, including any conditions relating to the shelf life or expiry date.

It is an offence to possess, have custody of, use, or deal with the product(s) bearing the cancelled label listed in the table in a manner that contravenes the above instructions.

Stop supply notice issued to Crop Smart Pty Ltd

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 102 OF THE AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY CHEMICALS CODE (AGVET CODE) SCHEDULED TO THE AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY CHEMICALS CODE ACT 1994. NO 1 OF 2019

On 2 May 2019, the APVMA issued a recall notice to Crop Smart Pty Ltd (Supplier) under section 102 of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (Agvet Code) scheduled to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994 (Cth) in relation to the following:

72 Intermediate Bulk Containers ('IBCs') of approximately 1000 litres volume, and most or all of which were or are now labelled or identified by one or more of the following descriptions:

- (i) Smart Triallate 500 EC Herbicide, or
- (ii) Tri-allate tech 93%, or
- (iii) Tri-allate tech 95%, or
- (iv) Batch: 2019ES0312 – Nongwa AgroChem Co., Limited, or
- (v) Batch: 2019ES0312 – CAC Nantong Chemical Company Ltd, or
- (vi) Batches; 20190105, 20190107, 20190109, 20190112, 20190115 -Jiangsu Aolunda High-Tech Industry Co., Ltd, or
- (vii) Batches; 20190105, 20190107, 20190109, 20190112, 20190115 –Lianyungang Neutech Chemicals Co. Ltd., or
- (viii) Batch: 10110112 (1-72) – Crop Smart Pty Ltd

*collectively 'the product'.

The notice requires the Supplier to:

- a) immediately stop supply of all stocks and batches of the product to any person;
- b) immediately recover all stocks and batches of the product from all persons to which they have been supplied by the Supplier;
- c) store the product, including those product recovered pursuant to paragraph 1(b), at a single location, and quarantine the product from other chemical products in its possession or control;
- d) immediately provide in writing to the APVMA the details of all Products supplied; including the relevant invoices and receipts, and the names and address of all persons to whom the product have been supplied, and the storage locations of those product;
- e) complete the actions listed herein by the dates specified (immediately and within 10 days) and undertake any other actions that the Supplier thinks necessary to give effect to the notice;
- f) provide, within 10 days, a report setting out the actions taken to comply with the notice; and
- g) provide, within 10 days, a report in relation to any stocks or batches which the Supplier has failed to recover in accordance with paragraph (b) above, including the quantity of Products, the name and address of the person to whom they were supplied, the date they were supplied, and copies of any communications with that person in relation to the Supplier's attempt to recover the product.

REASONS FOR THE NOTICE

The notice was issued on the grounds that it appears to the APVMA that the constituents of the stocks and batches of the product differ by more than the prescribed extent from the constituents of the registered chemical product Smart Triallate 500 EC Herbicide as recorded in the Register.

Amendments to the APVMA MRL Standard

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) approves maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. The MRLs approved by the APVMA are associated with a regulatory decision to register a product, grant a permit approval, or as an outcome from a review decision and are set out in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) 2012*. The *MRL Standard* lists MRLs of substances that may arise from the approved use of agricultural and veterinary chemical products containing those substances on commodities used for human consumption as well as livestock feeds. The *MRL Standard* also provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply. There may be situations where the residue definition for monitoring and enforcement is different to the definition used for dietary risk assessment purposes.

MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. In considering MRLs and variation to MRLs, the APVMA takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, toxicology, good agricultural practice and dietary exposure. In approving MRLs, the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels set are not an undue hazard to human health.

The APVMA has amended the *MRL Standard* and the changes will have affect the day after the instrument is registered.

Details of the amendment can be found in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) Amendment Instrument 2019 (No. 4)*.

The amendments will be incorporated into the compilation of the [Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 \(MRL Standard\) 2012](#).

Proposal to amend Schedule 20 in the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code

In the previous notice on page 20 of APVMA Gazette No. 10, the APVMA gazetted amendments which it has approved to vary maximum residue limits (MRLs) for substances contained in agricultural and veterinary chemical products as set out as in the APVMA's *MRL Standard*.

Under section 82 of the *Food Standards Australia New Zealand Act 1991*, the APVMA is proposing to incorporate those variations (*Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) Amendment Instrument 2019 (No. 4)*) to MRLs into Schedule 20—Maximum residue limits in the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code.

MRLs contained in Schedule 20 provide the limits for residues of agricultural and veterinary chemicals that may legitimately occur in foods. By this means, Schedule 20 permits the sale of treated foods and protects public health and safety by minimising residues in foods consistent with the effective control of pests and diseases.

The APVMA and Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) are satisfied, based on dietary exposure assessments and current health standards, that the proposed limits are not harmful to public health.

The agreement between the Australian Government and the New Zealand Government concerning a Joint Food Standards System, excludes MRLs for agricultural and veterinary chemicals in food from the system setting joint food standards. Australia and New Zealand independently and separately develop MRLs for agricultural and veterinary chemicals in food.

FSANZ will make a Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) notification to the World Trade Organization (WTO).

The APVMA invites comment on these proposals. Details on how to make a submission appear near the end of this notice, below the details of the proposed amendment.

The APVMA will consider any public comments made in response to this proposal. If the APVMA decides to proceed with the proposal, it will further notify any variations it makes to Schedule 20 in the APVMA Gazette. The variations will take effect as from the date of that subsequent notice.

Please note that FSANZ will make a SPS notification to the WTO and submissions related to impacts on international trade should be made to FSANZ in response to that notification.

Submissions must be made in writing and should be clearly marked as a 'submission on the proposed amendment to Schedule 20' and quote the correct amendment number.
