The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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## GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

## New Agricultural Active Constituent *Bacillus Amyloliquefaciens* Strain QST 713

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has before it an application for the approval of a new active constituent, *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713, for use as a biofungicide in agricultural products.

New taxonomic studies revealed that <i>Bacillus subtilis</i> QST 713 should be reclassified as <i>Bacillus amyloliquefaciens</i> strain QST 713. It is a gram-positive, motile rod measuring 1.0 µm × 3–5 µm with peritrichous flagella

### SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION

The APVMA has evaluated the chemistry aspects of *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713 active constituent (identification, manufacturing process, quality control procedures, batch analysis results and analytical methods) and found them to be acceptable.

On the basis of the data provided, and the toxicological assessment, it is proposed that the following APVMA Active Constituent Standard be established for *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713 active constituent:

Impurities of toxicological significance are not expected to occur in *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713 as a result of the raw materials and the fermentation process used.

The APVMA has considered the toxicological aspects of *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713, and concluded that there are no toxicological concerns to the approval of this active constituent. The organisms are not infective or pathogenic and were not toxic at limit doses in acute toxicity tests, consequently the establishment of an Acceptable Daily Intake (ADI), or of an Acute Reference Dose (ARfD), is not required.

Following a recommendation from the Advisory Committee on Chemical Substances (ACCS), the Scheduling Delegate for the Poisons Standard (commonly referred to as the *Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Medicines and Poisons—SUSMP*) has made a final decision regarding *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713 to be listed in Appendix B of the Poisons Standard (substances considered not to require control by scheduling), as a result of its low toxicity, with an implementation date of 1 February 2018.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed importation and use of *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713 would not be an undue toxicological hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

  - (iii) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of Serenade Opti Biofungicide containing the active constituent *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713 is not likely to be harmful to human beings if used according to the product label directions.
  - (iv) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of the new products Serenade Opti Biofungicide containing the active constituent *Bacillus amyloliquefaciens* strain QST 713, would not be likely to have an unintended effect that is harmful to animals, plants or things or the environment.
2. The APVMA has evaluated the application and in its assessment in relation to whether the efficacy criteria have been met in accordance with the definition set out in section 5B of the Agvet Code, and proposes to determine that:
  - (i) In relation to its assessment of efficacy under section 14(3)(f), the APVMA is satisfied that data from trials supporting the efficacy of the product adequately demonstrate that if used according to the product label directions, the product is effective for its proposed uses.

3. The APVMA has evaluated the application and in its assessment in relation to whether the trade criteria have been met in accordance with the definition set out in section 5C of the Agvet Code, and proposes to determine that:
- (i) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of Serenade Opti Biofungicide would not adversely affect trade between Australia and places outside Australia.
