Adoption of VICH guidelines GL 36 and GL 37

A program aimed at harmonising technical requirements for veterinary product registration was launched in Paris in April 1996, as a cooperative effort between members of the regulatory authorities and the veterinary chemical industry from the European Union, USA, and Japan. The program is the International Cooperation on Harmonisation of Technical Requirements for Registration of Veterinary Medicinal Products, known as VICH.

The APVMA and New Zealand's Agricultural compounds and Veterinary Medicines Group (ACVM) have observer status on the VICH Steering Committee.

VICH has finalised two new guidelines:

- VICH GL36: Studies to evaluate the safety of residues of veterinary drugs in human food: General approach to establish a microbiological ADI
- VICH GL37: Studies to evaluate the safety of residues of veterinary drugs in human food: Repeat-dose chronic toxicity testing

The APVMA published on its website, its proposal to adopt these two VICH guidelines and has not received adverse comment on this proposal.

NOTICE

Reconsideration of Approvals and Registrations Related to Carbaryl Part 1: Products Used In Home Garden, Home Veterinary, Poultry and Domestic Situation

The APVMA, in accordance with Part 2, Division 4, of the Agvet Codes, has reconsidered registrations of all products containing carbaryl for use in home garden, home veterinary, poultry and domestic situations and the approvals of all associated product labels.

Carbaryl is a carbamate insecticide used for the control of insect pests in a broad range of agricultural and domestic situations, including stored grain, ornamentals, lawns, fruit and vegetables and around public buildings. To a lesser extent it is also used in the control of insects on domestic animals. Formulations of carbaryl include emulsifiable concentrates, suspension concentrates, aqueous concentrates, wettable powders, ready-to-use dusts, ready-to-use liquids and solid formulations.

After the release of the Draft Report (June 2004) for carbaryl, it was determined that further assessments were required for the agricultural products. As a result the APVMA split the carbaryl review into two parts, with Part 1 considering home garden, home veterinary, poultry and domestic uses, and the Part 2 considering agricultural uses.

Following the finalisation of its reconsideration of home garden, home veterinary, poultry and domestic products, the APVMA is satisfied that the conditions to which three label approvals are currently subject can be varied in the way to ensure that the requirements for continued label approval will be complied with. Therefore the APVMA has varied the conditions of label approval for the labels listed in Table 1.

The APVMA is satisfied that the labels of products listed in Table 1 have been varied and that the products meet the prescribed requirements for continued registration.

On this basis the APVMA is satisfied that continued registration of the products in accordance with their instructions for use:

- would not be an undue hazard to the safety of people exposed to them during their handling or people using anything containing their residues; and
- would not be likely to have an effect that is harmful to human beings,

and therefore has affirmed the product registrations.

The APVMA is not satisfied that the currently approved labels for containers of Kendon Carbaryl Wettable Powder Insecticide (APVMA Number 49326) contain adequate instructions relating to the matters referred to in s.14(3)(g) of the Agvet Codes as well as those referred to in regulations 11 and 12 of the Agvet Code Regulations, where the product is used in the home garden, since amount of carbaryl exceeds the safety threshold of 160 g/kg (or g/L).

However, the APVMA is satisfied that the currently approved labels for containers of Kendon Carbaryl Wettable Powder Insecticide (49326) can be varied in such a way that they contain adequate instructions relating to the matters referred to in s.14(3)(g) of the Agvet Codes as well as those referred to in regulations 11 and 12 of the Agvet Code Regulations.

Thus the APVMA has varied the approved label by deleting pack sizes 200 g, 500 g and 1 kg, as well as the instructions for use in the home garden on the approved labels of Kendon Carbaryl Wettable Powder Insecticide (49326).

The APVMA is not satisfied that the labels for products in Table 2 contain adequate instructions in relation to the criteria set out in section 14 (3)(g) of the Agvet Codes as well as those referred to in Regulations 11 and 12 of the Agvet Code Regulations. Product labels also contain use patterns that have been deleted.

The APVMA is not satisfied that the conditions of registration of these products can be varied in such a way that the requirements for continued registration will be complied with. Therefore, the APVMA is not satisfied that continued registration of the products in accordance with their instructions for use:

- would not be an undue hazard to the safety of people exposed to them during their handling or people using anything containing their residues; and
- would not be likely to have an effect that is harmful to human beings.

On this basis the registrations of products and all approved labels in Table 2 have been cancelled.

AMENDMENT No.7J

AMENDMENTS TO THE MRL STANDARD

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) sets maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. These MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. At the same time the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels are not an undue hazard to human health.

The MRL Standard lists MRLs of substances which may arise from the approved use of those substances or other substances, and provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply.

The evaluation process takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, good agricultural practice, toxicology and dietary exposure. From time to time the evaluation process results in amendments to the MRL Standard. It should be noted that relevant MRLs are referred to Food Standards Australia New Zealand for incorporation into Standard 1.4.2 of the Food Standards Code entitled "Maximum Residue Limits".

Note: ‘*’ denotes that the maximum residue limit (MRL) has been set at or about the limit of analytical quantitation (see: Residue Guideline No.4, *Maximum Residue Limit Proposals 'At or about the Limit of Analytical Quantitation'*, published in NRA Gazette No.9, p44, 5/9/95).

‘T’ denotes that the MRL, residue definition or use is temporary to enable further experimental work to be carried out in Australia or overseas, and will be reconsidered at some future date.
