The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the Gazette containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*.

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**GENERAL INFORMATION**

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides & Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published monthly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation, and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

The APVMA has suspended the approvals for 2,4-D ethyl ester, 2,4-D butyl ester and 2,4-D isobutyl ester active constituents listed in the following table

The suspensions are in effect from **17 December 2008 until 17 July 2009**.

### Reasons

The reasons for the Suspension action<sup>1</sup> [s.37(1)(b) Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994] arises from the fact that only one company responded to the APVMA's notice of 12 September 2007 to all 2,4-D HVE approval holders requiring the provision of additional data. The additional data received by the APVMA only supports the following active constituent approvals and products containing these active constituents:

- 47189 2,4-D ethyl ester

The following active constituents and products containing these active constituents are NOT affected by this suspension as they were not subject to the 12 September 2007 provision of additional data requirements:

- 59395 2,4-D ethyl ester
- 59931 2,4-D isobutyl ester

The APVMA has issued the following instructions for using or dealing with suspended active constituent and products.

<b>INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSSESSING, HAVING CUSTODY OF, USING OR DEALING WITH SUSPENDED ACTIVE CONSTITUENT AND SUSPENDED PRODUCTS</b>

#### *Possession and custody*

A person may not possess, have custody of, use or deal with the above active constituents. Products manufactured and in the wholesale and retail supply chain as of 17 December 2008 may be in a persons possession and custody, used and dealt with **only** in accordance with the instructions as stated in the suspension notice published in the APVMA Gazette 5, 1 May 2007 page 21.

NO further manufacture of active constituents or products listed above is permitted during the course of the suspension.

#### *Supply*

Product may only be supplied if it was manufactured prior to 17 December 2008 and in the wholesale and retail supply chain at that time. Any such supply of these products **MUST** be in accordance with the instructions for supply as stated in the suspension notice published in the APVMA Gazette 5, 1 May 2007 page 21.

#### *Use*

Product may only be used if it was manufactured prior to 17 December 2008 and in the wholesale and retail supply chain at that time. Any such use of these products **MUST** be in accordance with the instructions for supply as stated in the suspension notice published in the APVMA Gazette 5, 1 May 2007 page 21.

Subsections 45A(5) and 55(3) cease to apply in respect of the above products. A person may not possess, have custody of, use or deal with the above active constituents and products.

### Warning

<sup>1</sup> These actions form part of the review ("reconsideration") of 2,4-D active constituent approvals, product registrations and associated label approvals. Approvals and registrations granted after the commencement of the review in 2003 are subject to the outcomes of the current review of 2,4-D as notified in the July 2003 gazette (page 42) and stated in the conditions of registration.

These actives are not approved, products are unregistered and labels are not approved during the period of suspension. A person must not possess with the intent to supply, or deal with any of these active constituents, products or labels during this period except in accordance with the instructions contained in this notice. A failure to comply with them will result in an offence against the Agvet Codes and the APVMA will take appropriate compliance action.

*Revocation of the suspension*

The APVMA must revoke a suspension imposed under s.37(3) of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994, when it has received the results of the trials or experiments [issued by notice on 12 September 2007 to all 2,4-D HVE approval holders].

**Further regulatory action**

If the information or the results of the trials or experiments are not given to the APVMA by the 17 July 2009, the APVMA may cancel the approval and/or registration.

**AMENDMENTS TO THE  
MRL STANDARD**

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) sets maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. These MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. At the same time the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels are not an undue hazard to human health.

The MRL Standard lists MRLs of substances which may arise from the approved use of those substances or other substances, and provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply.

The evaluation process takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, good agricultural practice, toxicology and dietary exposure. From time to time the evaluation process results in amendments to the MRL Standard. It should be noted that relevant MRLs are referred to Food Standards Australia New Zealand for incorporation into Standard 1.4.2 of the Food Standards Code entitled "Maximum Residue Limits".

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**Note:** ‘\*’ denotes that the maximum residue limit (MRL) has been set at or about the limit of analytical quantitation (see: Residue Guideline No.4, *Maximum Residue Limit Proposals 'At or about the Limit of Analytical Quantitation'*, published in NRA Gazette No.9, p44, 5/9/95).

‘T’ denotes that the MRL, residue definition or use is temporary to enable further experimental work to be carried out in Australia or overseas, and will be reconsidered at some future date.
