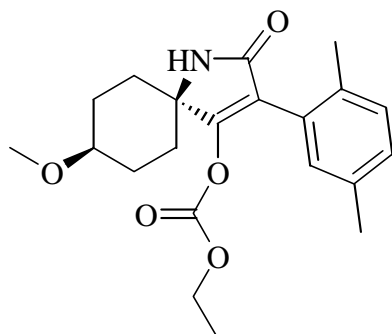

In accordance with section 12 of the Agvet Code, the APVMA invites any person to submit a relevant written submission as to whether the application for approval of spirotetramat should be granted. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Such grounds should relate only to the matters that the APVMA is required to take into account in deciding whether to grant the approval. Summary of the APVMA's Evaluation of Spirotetramat Active Constituent

The Chemistry Section of the APVMA has evaluated the chemistry aspects of spirotetramat active constituent (manufacturing process, quality control procedures, batch analysis results and analytical methods) and found them to be acceptable.

On the basis of the data provided, it is proposed that the following APVMA Active Constituent Standard be established for spirotetramat active constituent:

Constituent	Specification	Level
Spirotetramat	Spirotetramat	Not less than 960 g/kg

Other compounds of toxicological significance are not expected to occur in spirotetramat as a result of the raw materials and the synthetic route used.

The Office of Chemical Safety of the Therapeutic Goods Administration has considered the toxicological aspects of spirotetramat, and advised that there are no toxicological objections to the approval of this chemical.

An acceptable daily intake (ADI) of 0.05 mg/kg bw/d is recommended based on a No Observed Effect Level (NOEL) of 5 mg/kg bw/d in a 12-month dog study and using a safety factor of 100, and an Acute Reference Dose (ARfD) of 1 mg/kg bw, based on a NOEL of 100 mg/kg bw/d in an acute neurotoxicity study and using a safety factor of 100, have been established.

The National Drugs and Poisons Schedule Committee (NDPSC) has included spirotetramat into Schedule 6 of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons (SUSDP).

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisers on these criteria.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed importation and use of spirotetramat would not be an undue toxicological hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

In accordance with sections 12 and 13 of the Agvet Code, the APVMA invites any person to submit a relevant written submission as to whether the application for registration should be granted. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Such grounds should relate only to matters outlined below that the APVMA is required to take into account in deciding whether to grant the application. Summary of the APVMA's evaluation of *MOVENTO* in accordance with Section 14(3)(e) and (f) of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the 'Agvet Code'), scheduled to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994

The APVMA has evaluated the application and in its assessment in relation to human and environmental safety under section 14(3)(e) of the Agvet Code, it proposes to determine that:

- (i) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of *MOVENTO* would not be an undue hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

The Office of Chemical Safety (OCS) has conducted a risk assessment on *MOVENTO* and concluded that it can be used safely. *MOVENTO* was found to have low acute oral, dermal and inhalational toxicity. *MOVENTO* is a slight eye irritant and a skin sensitiser but not a skin irritant. Personal protective equipment has been recommended based on acute and repeat dose risk assessments. Based on estimated post application dermal exposure for workers undertaking crop management activities, a re-entry statement was recommended.

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of the OCS evaluation.

The product will be formulated overseas and repackaging will be required in Australia.

Based on product toxicology information, *MOVENTO* is classified as a hazardous substance in accordance with NOHSC Approved Criteria for Classifying Hazardous Substances (NOHSC, 2004).

- (ii) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of *MOVENTO* will not be an undue hazard to the safety of people using anything containing its residues. Residue data were assessed by the APVMA and Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs) are recommended for Spirotetramat when used on brassica vegetable crops. These are as follows: Brassica (cole or cabbage) vegetables, head cabbages, flowerhead brassicas [except Brussels sprouts] 7 mg/kg; Brussels sprouts 1 mg/kg. Associated animal commodity MRLs are edible offal (mammalian) 0.05 mg/kg; meat (mammalian) *0.01 mg/kg and milks *0.005 mg/kg.
- (iii) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of the *MOVENTO* containing the active Spirotetramat is not likely to be harmful to human beings if used according to the product label directions.

The active constituents have been evaluated and approved and the product is scheduled as 6. The appropriate Signal Heading is on the label. First Aid and Safety Directions for Spirotetramat have been recommended by the OCS in the Commonwealth Department of Health and Ageing and have been included on the label.

The data package provided in the present submission contains eight metabolism studies and thirty-six toxicology studies on the active constituent and seven toxicology studies on the product for which Australian registration is sought. All studies relied on for this assessment have been conducted in accordance with contemporary toxicity testing guidelines and are considered to be adequate for the assessment of the toxicology profile of spirotetramat, and the establishment of Safety Directions for the product.

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisers on this criteria.

- (iv) **The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of *MOVENTO* containing the active Spirotetramat on brassica vegetable crops is not likely to have an unintended effect that is harmful to animals, plants or the environment.**

The Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts (DEWHA) has assessed data in support of *MOVENTO* and believes that the application contains adequate environmental fate and toxicity data to demonstrate that the use of *MOVENTO* according to the label is unlikely to result in primary poisonings of wildlife, fish etc.

Spirotetramat rapidly dissipates in terrestrial and aquatic environments, but its major metabolite is more persistent and may persist between spray applications. Degradation of this metabolite is primarily via aerobic metabolism, with a distinct biphasic pattern in soil, reflective of strong soil binding and slow release. Spirotetramat is moderately mobile in soil but is not expected to leach extensively. Although the metabolite has high mobility, most remains strongly sequestered to the topsoil. Spirotetramat has low potential for bioaccumulation.

Spirotetramat is moderately toxic to fish, with higher levels of toxicity observed in some aquatic invertebrates and algae. Birds are not acutely sensitive to spirotetramat but adverse effects have been observed in ducks from prolonged exposure. Although spirotetramat is generally non-toxic to bees, feeding in the field has been shown to affect brood development. Mammals, soil microorganisms, earthworms, gamasid mites and a range of foliar invertebrates were generally insensitive (except for predatory mites) to spirotetramat, and terrestrial plants are unlikely to be harmed.

The risk to aquatic species and terrestrial plants is acceptable based on the results of spray drift modelling, with no buffers required for ground applications. An acceptable risk is expected for birds and bees at the proposed application rates. There is likely to be an acceptable risk to terrestrial invertebrates from the proposed ground application provided that the label is amended to include a warning statement regarding the use of the product where Integrated Pest Management (IPM) is practiced.

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisers on this criteria.

- (v) The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of Spirotetramat would not adversely affect trade between Australia and places outside Australia. The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed use of **MOVENTO** should not adversely affect trade between Australia and places outside Australia. Quantifiable residues are likely to occur in harvested Brassica crops when **MOVENTO** is used in accordance with the label directions and Good Agricultural Practice. However, Brassica crops are not major export commodities and the label advises users to consider residue standards in export markets prior to use on produce grown for export.

The likelihood of detectable residues occurring in animal commodities as a result of animal exposure to treated Brassica crops is considered small. Accordingly, the use **MOVENTO** on Brassica crops is not expected to unduly prejudice Australian trade in animal commodities.

In relation to its assessment of efficacy under section 14(3)(f), the APVMA proposes to determine that:

- (i) The APVMA is satisfied the data from trials supporting the efficacy of **MOVENTO** adequately demonstrates that under local conditions this product is effective for the proposed uses.

Amendments to the MRL Standard

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) sets maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. These MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. At the same time the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels are not an undue hazard to human health.

The MRL Standard lists MRLs of substances which may arise from the approved use of those substances or other substances, and provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply.

The evaluation process takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, good agricultural practice, toxicology and dietary exposure. From time to time the evaluation process results in amendments to the MRL Standard. It should be noted that relevant MRLs are referred to Food Standards Australia New Zealand for incorporation into Standard 1.4.2 of the Food Standards Code entitled "Maximum Residue Limits".

Note: ‘*’ denotes that the maximum residue limit (MRL) has been set at or about the limit of analytical quantitation (see: Residue Guideline No.4, *Maximum Residue Limit Proposals ‘At or about the Limit of Analytical Quantitation’*, published in NRA Gazette No.9, p44, 5/9/95).

‘T’ denotes that the MRL, residue definition or use is temporary to enable further experimental work to be carried out in Australia or overseas, and will be reconsidered at some future date.
