The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the Gazette containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the Gazette.

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## GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 53(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

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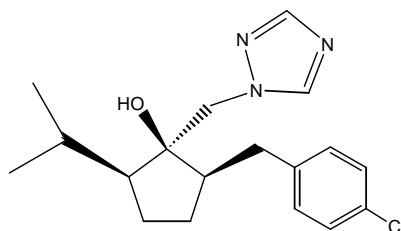

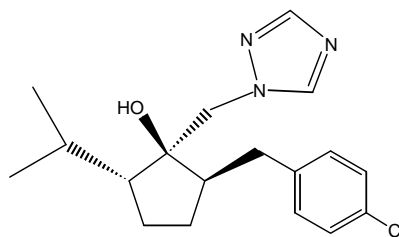

## SUMMARY OF THE APVMA'S EVALUATION OF IPCONAZOLE ACTIVE CONSTITUENT

The Pesticides Program of the APVMA has evaluated the chemistry aspects of ipconazole active constituent (manufacturing process, quality control procedures, batch analysis results and analytical methods) and found them to be acceptable.

On the basis of the data provided, and the toxicological assessment, it is proposed that the following APVMA Active Constituent Standard be established for ipconazole active constituent:

Other compounds of toxicological significance are not expected to occur in ipconazole TGAC as a result of the raw materials and the synthetic route used.

The Office of Chemical Safety and Environmental Health has considered the toxicological aspects of ipconazole TGAC, and advised that there are no toxicological objections to the approval of this chemical.

An Acceptable Daily Intake (ADI) of 0.015 mg/kg bw/d has been recommended, based on a No-Observed Effect Level (NOEL) of 1.5 mg/kg bw/d in a 1-year chronic toxicity study, after applying a safety factor of 100.

An Acute Reference Dose (ARfD) has not been set since ipconazole TGAC is not considered likely to present an acute hazard (including developmental toxicity) to humans.

The National Drugs and Poisons Schedule Committee (NDPSC) has considered ipconazole TGAC to be appropriate for inclusion in Schedule 6 of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons (SUSDP).

The APVMA accepts the findings and recommendations of its advisers on these criteria.

The APVMA is satisfied that the proposed importation and use of ipconazole would not be an undue toxicological hazard to the safety of people exposed to it during its handling and use.

## MAKING A SUBMISSION

In accordance with sections 12 of the Agvet Code, the APVMA invites any person to submit a relevant written submission as to whether the application for approval of ipconazole should be granted. Submissions should relate only to matters that the APVMA is required by legislation to consider in deciding whether to grant the approval. These grounds include **chemistry and manufacture, and toxicity**. Submissions should state the grounds on which they are based. Comments received outside these grounds cannot be considered by the APVMA.

Submissions must be received by the APVMA within **28 days** of the date of this notice and be directed to the contact listed below. All submissions to the APVMA will be acknowledged in writing via email or by post. A summary of relevant comments and the APVMA's response will be published on the APVMA website.

### Exemption for the purposes of Sections 75 and 78 of the Agvet Codes : Vets All Natural Pty Ltd

The APVMA has granted exemptions for the purposes of sections 75 (1)(b) and 78 (1)(b) of the Agvet Codes for the following Vets All Natural Products

- Vet's All Natural Omega blend in 500 mL containers;
- Vet's All Natural Medi Treats Joint Support in 100 g containers;
- Vet's All Natural Medi Treats Shark Cartilage Chews in 100 g containers;
- Vet's All Natural Medi Treats Skin Support 100 g containers.

The conditions of the exemptions are as follows:
