Interim Decision on the APVMA's Cost Recovery Arrangements

In early 2008 the APVMA commenced a review of its cost recovery arrangements. The APVMA sought stakeholder input into this process and released a draft Cost Recovery Impact Statement (CRIS) in December 2008. A final CRIS was produced in August 2009.

The Hon Tony Burke, Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry, has recently advised that he has decided to increase a range of fees charged by the APVMA by 10% effective from 1 July 2010. This increase will apply to the annual fee on product registrations, new application fees for evaluation and approval (category and modular applications), HGP notification number application and renewal fees, Certificate of Export fees, new GMP licences and database information fees. Levies will not change.

This change, subject to a change in the appropriate regulation, will be given effect by a variation to an earlier CRIS developed for the APVMA by the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) in 2005.

The Minister has advised that the increase is an interim measure and that further changes to the APVMA's cost recovery arrangements will be considered within twelve months in line with expected reforms to the operation of the APVMA.

Administratively, a letter advising of the revised annual fee and payment arrangements will soon be sent to all registrants. The new annual fee will apply to products maintained on the register for 2010-2011. A revised schedule of application and licence fees will also be developed. Information on these matters and related implementation issues will be published on the cost recovery page of the APVMA website at www.apvma.gov.au/costrecovery and communicated in the APVMA's *Gazette* and email newsletter *Regulatory Update*.

Going forward, the APVMA will be liaising with DAFF to review and publish an amended version of the 2005 CRIS.

The APVMA will also put processes in place so that further changes to the cost recovery arrangements can be considered as part of the broader reform agenda currently underway.

Key elements of the CRIS developed by the APVMA in August 2009 will provide an important input into these wider considerations.

Systematic Spray Drift Reviews – Reconsideration of Label Approvals of Products Containing 2,4-D

The APVMA, in accordance with Part 2, Division 4, s.34A of the Agvet Codes, is reconsidering the approvals of all labels associated with products containing 2,4-D.

2,4-D (2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid) is a phenoxy compound used as a post-emergence herbicide. It is used for the selective control of annual and perennial broadleaf weeds in an extensive range of crops and non-cropping situations. A large number of products containing 2,4-D, either as the only active constituent or together with other active constituents, is currently registered for use in Australia for weed control.

The basis of the reconsideration of all associated labels of products containing the active constituent 2,4-D is whether or not the labels contain adequate instructions and warning statements that ensure the APVMA is satisfied that continued use of these products in accordance with the instructions for its use would not likely have an unintended effect that is harmful to animals, plants or things or to the environment.

The scope of this reconsideration will cover the environmental aspects of label approvals for 2,4-D, in order to address APVMA's concerns about the potential risk of non-target damage that spray drift of such products can cause.

The APVMA has conducted spray drift modelling and risk analysis for products containing 2,4-D. The assessment showed that spray drift of 2,4-D may pose risks to aquatic organisms, non-target terrestrial vegetation and neighbouring crops.

It appears that the labels for products containing 2,4-D may not comply with the prescribed requirements under paragraph 14(3)(d) and contain the adequate instructions relating to the matters referred to in paragraph 14(3)(g) of the Agvet Codes.

Thus it is necessary to place all associated label approvals of products containing 2,4-D under reconsideration to make label amendments, if necessary, to mitigate spray drift risks.

The APVMA will consider whether product labels carry adequate instructions and warning statements. The requirements for product labels are that the label contains adequate instructions. Such instructions include:

- the circumstances in which the product should be used;
- how the product should be used;
- the times when the product should be used;
- the frequency of the use of the product;
- any other matter prescribed by the regulations.

Label approvals of the products containing 2,4-D that are being reconsidered are listed in Table 1.

The APVMA's detailed reasons for these reconsiderations can be found in the APVMA's 2,4-D Spray Drift Review Scope document, available on the APVMA website (www.apvma.gov.au).

Amendments to the MRL Standard

AMENDMENT NO. 11M

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) sets maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. These MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. At the same time the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels are not an undue hazard to human health.

The MRL Standard lists MRLs of substances which may arise from the approved use of those substances or other substances, and provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply.

The evaluation process takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, good agricultural practice, toxicology and dietary exposure. From time to time the evaluation process results in amendments to the MRL Standard. It should be noted that relevant MRLs are referred to Food Standards Australia New Zealand for incorporation into Standard 1.4.2 of the Food Standards Code entitled "Maximum Residue Limits".

Note: "*" denotes that the maximum residue limit (MRL) has been set at or about the limit of analytical quantitation (see: Residue Guideline No.4, *Maximum Residue Limit Proposals 'At or about the Limit of Analytical Quantitation'*, published in NRA Gazette No.9, p44, 5/9/95).

'T' denotes that the MRL, residue definition or use is temporary to enable further experimental work to be carried out in Australia or overseas, and will be reconsidered at some future date.
