The *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Act) commenced on 15 March 1995. The Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) scheduled to the Act requires notices to be published in the *Gazette* containing details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemical products and other approvals granted by the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority. The Agvet Code and related legislation also requires certain other notices to be published in the *Gazette*. A reference to Agvet Codes in this publication is a reference to the Agvet Code in each state and territory jurisdiction.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

The *APVMA (Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority) Gazette* is published fortnightly and contains details of the registration of agricultural and veterinary chemicals products and other approvals granted by the APVMA, notices as required by the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (the Agvet Code) and related legislation and a range of regulatory material issued by the APVMA.

Pursuant to section 8J(1) of the Agvet Code, the APVMA has decided that it is unnecessary to publish details of applications made for the purpose of notifying minor variations to registration details. The APVMA will however report notifications activity in quarterly statistical reports.

Section 44(1) of the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code scheduled to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Agvet Code), states that if the APVMA cancels the approval of an active constituent for an existing chemical product, it must also cancel any registration of that product.

Section 44(2) of the Agvet Code states that if the APVMA cancels the registration of a chemical product, it may also cancel any approval relating to a label for containers for the chemical product.

Lebaycid Insecticide Spray (product number 32996), and Amalgamated Pest Control Fenthion 1% Dust Insecticide (product number 41138) contain the active constituent fenthion (approval number). The APVMA has, therefore, cancelled the registrations of these two products and all associated labels.

The following instructions set out how a person can deal with the cancelled products.

INSTRUCTIONS

Manufacture or import of the listed products after 3 November 2014 is not authorised.

Any person who possesses, has custody of, uses, or otherwise deals with the cancelled products may possess, have custody of, use or otherwise deal with the product in accordance with the instructions in this notice only for a period of 12 months ending 2 November 2015.

After 2 November 2015 it will be an offence against the Agvet Codes to supply these products, or to have possession or custody of these products with the intention to supply.

SUPPLY

Products manufactured prior to 3 November 2014 may be supplied or cause to be supplied, at wholesale and retail level only until 2 November 2015.

After 2 November 2015 it will be an offence against the Agvet Codes to supply these products, or to have possession or custody of these products with the intention to supply.

USE

Any person who possesses, has custody of, uses, or otherwise deals with the listed products in accordance with the instructions in this notice, is taken to have been issued with a permit under the Agvet Codes to so possess, have custody of, use or otherwise deal with the products after the registration has been cancelled until 2 November 2015.

The supply and use of the products must be in accordance with the conditions of registration or approval, including any conditions relating to the shelf life or expiry date.

It is an offence to possess, have custody of, use, or deal with the products listed in the table in a manner that contravenes the instructions in this notice. Specific instructions are provided below:

WARNING

A person must not possess with the intent to supply, or deal with the cancelled products except in accordance with the instructions contained in this notice. A failure to comply with them will result in an offence against the Agvet Codes and the APVMA will take appropriate compliance action. It will be an offence for any person to possess with the intent to supply, or deal with the products after 2 November 2015.

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Exemption from Offence Provisions

EXEMPTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 75 AND SECTION 78

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has determined, as provided for under sections 75(1)(b) and 78(1)(b) of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Code Act 1994* (the Agvet Code), that the products listed below are exempt from the operation of section 75 and section 78 of the Agvet Code.

Products subject to this exemption

1. *Zagrosol AD3E (oral solution)*
2. *Amilyte (water soluble powder)*
3. *Nilstress (water soluble powder)*
4. *Zagrosol Minpro (oral solution)*
5. *Zagrosol Aminogen (oral solution)*
6. *Calpozag (oral solution)*

This exemption is granted for the period of 7 October 2014 to 7 March 2014 inclusive.

While in force this exemption means that while the products are veterinary chemicals, as defined by section 5 of the Agvet Code, and unregistered, it is not an offence to possess them for the purposes of supply or to supply them.

This exemption can be cancelled or amended at any time by the APVMA.

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Amendments to the APVMA MRL Standard

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) approves maximum residue limits (MRLs) of agricultural and veterinary chemicals in agricultural produce, particularly produce entering the food chain. The MRLs approved by the APVMA are associated with a regulatory decision to register a product, grant a permit approval, or as an outcome from a review decision and are set out in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) 2012*. The *MRL Standard* lists MRLs of substances that may arise from the approved use of agricultural and veterinary chemical products containing those substances on commodities used for human consumption as well as livestock feeds. The *MRL Standard* also provides the relevant residue definitions to which these MRLs apply. There may be situations where the residue definition for monitoring and enforcement is different to the definition used for dietary risk assessment purposes.

MRLs are set at levels which are not likely to be exceeded if the agricultural or veterinary chemicals are used in accordance with approved label instructions. In considering MRLs and variation to MRLs, the APVMA takes into account studies on chemistry, metabolism, analytical methodology, residues, toxicology, good agricultural practice and dietary exposure. In approving MRLs, the APVMA is satisfied, from dietary exposure assessment, that the levels set are not an undue hazard to human health.

The APVMA has amended the *MRL Standard* with effect from 4 November 2014.

Details of the amendment can be found in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) Amendment Instrument 2014 (No. 10)*.

The amendments will be incorporated into the compilation of the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) 2012*.

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Proposal to Amend Standard 1.4.2 of the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code

In the previous notice, the APVMA gazetted that amendments which it has approved varying maximum residue limits (MRLs) for substances contained in agricultural and veterinary chemical products as set out as in the APVMA's *MRL Standard*, have been made.

Under Section 82 of the *Food Standards Australia New Zealand Act 1991* the APVMA is proposing to incorporate those variations (*Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Instrument No. 4 (MRL Standard) Amendment Instrument 2014 (No. 10)*) to MRLs into Standard 1.4.2. Maximum Residue Limits of the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code.

MRLs contained in Standard 1.4.2 provide the limits for residues of agricultural and veterinary chemicals that may legitimately occur in foods. By this means, Standard 1.4.2 permits the sale of treated foods and protects public health and safety by minimising residues in foods consistent with the effective control of pests and diseases.

The APVMA and FSANZ are satisfied, based on dietary exposure assessments and current health standards, that the proposed limits are not harmful to public health.

The Agreement between the Government of Australia and the Government of New Zealand concerning a Joint Food Standards System, excludes MRLs for agricultural and veterinary chemicals in food from the system setting joint food standards. Australia and New Zealand independently and separately develop MRLs for agricultural and veterinary chemicals in food.

Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) will make a Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) notification to the World Trade Organization (WTO).

The APVMA invites comment on these proposals. Details on how to make a submission appear near the end of this notice, below the details of the proposed amendment.

The APVMA will consider any public comments made in response to this proposal. If the APVMA decides to proceed with the proposal, it will further notify any variations it makes to Standard 1.4.2 in the APVMA *Gazette*. The variations will take effect as from the date of that subsequent notice.

DRAFT VARIATIONS TO THE AUSTRALIA NEW ZEALAND FOOD STANDARDS CODE

Submissions should be strictly confined to relevant matters that the APVMA must consider (such as public health and safety) which are associated with the occurrence of the proposed residues in foods. Comments received outside these grounds will not be considered by the APVMA. Claims made in submissions should be supported wherever possible by referencing or including relevant studies, research findings, trials, surveys etc. Technical information should be in sufficient detail to allow independent scientific assessment.

Please note that FSANZ will make a SPS notification to the WTO and submissions related to impacts on international trade should be made to FSANZ in response to that notification.

Submissions must be made in writing and should be clearly marked as a 'submission on the proposed amendment to Standard 1.4.2' and quote the correct amendment number.
